COSHH FORM WITH INSTRUMENT DELIVERY

Please take note that no instrument will be accepted onto our premises without the legally required “Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations” (COSHH) Declaration Form being available and visible on the outside of the packaging. This must be displayed clearly so that before the Receiver opens the packaging, they are aware of its contents and potential hazards.


This statement is based on following excerpt from the Occupational Health and Safety Act (85 of 1993) section 10 states:

10. General duties of manufacturers and others regarding articles and substances for use at work
 - 1) Any person who designs, manufactures, imports, sells or supplies, any article for use at work shall ensure, as far as is reasonably practicable, that the article is safe and without risks to health when properly used and that it complies with all prescribed requirements.
 - 2) Any person who manufactures, imports, sells or supplies any substance for use at work shall-
 - (a) ensure as far as is reasonably practicable, that the substance is safe and without risk to health when properly used; and
 - (b) take such steps as may be necessary to ensure that information is available with regard to the use of the substance at work, the risks to health and safety associated with such substance, the conditions necessary to ensure that the substance will be safe and without risks to health when properly used and the procedure to be followed in the case of an accident involving such substance.
 - a. Where a person designs, manufactures, imports, sells or supplies an article or substance for or to another person and that other person undertakes in writing to take specified steps sufficient to ensure, as far as is reasonably practicable, that the article or substance will comply with all prescribed requirements and will be safe and without risks to health when properly used, the undertaking shall have the effect of relieving the first mentioned person from the duty imposed upon him by this section to such an extent as may be reasonable having regard to the terms of the undertaking.

Should any hazardous substance have relevance when completing the Asset’s COSHH Declaration Form, then the respective Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) must also be available and visible alongside the COSHH Declaration Form on the outside of the package.


If there is no COSHH form available and visible on the outside of the packaging, the package will be sent back to the Sender via the mode of Initial Delivery.

This will be implemented without exception from the 02nd March 2020.
